DRIVERS EDUCATION

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Belle Plaine Community Ed provides classroom and behind-the-wheel drivers education instruction for students ages 14 and older. This class meets the 30hour requirement to prepare for a learner's permit. Payment covers the 30-hour Classroom fee and 6-hours of Behind the Wheel.

CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION: 30 Hours

Classroom includes lecture, class discussion, videos, written work from the driver's manual and practice tests. Upon completion, students will be issued a blue card. Please bring school iPad to class each day.

BEHIND-THE-WHEEL (BTW): 6 Hours

Behind-the-Wheel allows students to practice driving on public streets and highways with an instructor. This is the required course students take after they have earned their learner's permit. Successful completion is required before a student can take their driver's examination.

If you are concerned about a child's development, you can refer the child through Help Me Grow for a free screening or evaluation. Services are free to eligible children ages birth-5, regardless of income or immigrant status.


