1. The Bloodborne Pathogens (BBP) exposure control officer is Rachelle Kerkow. Jeff Heine is also a program coordinator for the BBP program.
2. The Bloodborne Pathogens written program and records are located Rachelle Kerkow (Oakcrest Elementary) and Jeff Heine's Offices (High School).
3. ISD #716 trains all staff members annually.
4. If you have any incident involving blood, immediately contact Rachelle or Jeff, and they will assist you in completing the BBP Exposure Incident Forms.
5. Hepatitis B Vaccination:
  - a. If you are a new employee, please fill out a Hepatitis B vaccination declination/acceptance form (we need one on file for each employee). See Jeff or Rachelle for the form
  - b. If you have not been offered the Hepatitis B vaccination, or have declined in the past and wish to have the shot series now, or need any other information, please contact Jeff or Rachelle
